

Project 1 RV Fenceline Arbor Vitae

The project described below will be on the 2019 General Meeting Ballot. Here's information so that you can make your decision.

Project Description: Plant a row of Arbor Vitae trees along the RV fence line on Blue Heron (see map below – the red lines point to where the new trees would go).

Project Purpose: This project continues the line of existing Arbor Vitae trees. The purpose is to screen the fence and beautification.

Project Background & Funding: This project is funded through using HOA dues and general savings. No new dues will be assessed for this project. Trees will be sourced from Costco that provides the lowest cost tree and provides a guarantee. Total estimated cost \$3130: 40 Trees \$1200; Labor \$1200; Supplies \$480, Trencher \$250

Project Endorsement: This project is endorsed and recommended by the HOA Board and by the Landscape Committee.

Plant Choice: The Emerald Green Giant quickly gives you a lush, rich privacy screen as it grows to 15' tall, 3-4' wide.

Irrigation: Irrigation is provided with existing water shares owned by the HOA. An existing irrigation line will be extended along the fence line and buried under a driveway.

Maintenance Requirements: These trees, once established, require little to no maintenance. No pruning is required. Occasional spraying and fertilizing may be required. Drippers must be checked annually, and the existing filter should be cleaned weekly.
